- **Find or share a service-learning syllabus** at the [national resource library](#) or in [GlobalSL](#), a collection of resources about creating community-driven partnerships across cultures, anywhere in the world.
- **Listen** to the [Compact Nation Podcast](#), a bi-monthly show exploring issues related to civic engagement in higher education.
- **Get involved!** Faculty can apply to a year-long fellowship as an [Engaged Faculty Scholar](#), graduates can apply to be part of the Compact's [AmeriCorps VISTA](#) program, campus leaders can seek an [Election Engagement](#) grant, and more.
